

HOW TO INSTALL THE BEAST BUILD ON KODI KRYPTON v17.x

NOTE: This tutorial is based on that you have already installed KODI.

**** You should also run the fresh start app prior to installing any new builds.**

The Beast install, Registration Setup

1. Need to register first prior to installing build.
2. Visit URL <http://thebeast2.com/signup/register.php?us-site> and skip the donation popup. Scroll right down to the bottom of page and you will see a login section.
3. You now need to create an account. Just put any email address in (fake one) and enter password. You need to remember the credentials as it is important. So don't forget it.
4. When you are done, you will need to verify your account that you just created at the current webpage. Don't worry you won't get any emails or stuff like that. You can verify all within your account.
5. You are DONE!

**** This step is ONLY if you have a public build installed on top of kodi e.g. TheBeast, Titan etc..**

Start TheBeast, once it is running, navigate to **APPS**, move down to submenus and select **ADD-ON BROWSER** hit enter. Select Search, now enter **fresh** press enter, now you will probably see a list of programs, the program you want is called **Media Sources – FRESH START** hit enter. Once it finishes downloading click on **INSTALL**. Now click **OPEN**. If it opens properly then it will ask you if you want to default to factory settings. Click **YES**. This will wipe all of TheBeast build and it will ask you to reboot. Once it reboots then you can follow the next section of this tutorial.

Start KODI, at the MAIN MENU, click the GEAR icon below the KODI logo

Now let's install the The Beast Build for KODI.

File Manager, Add Source, enter the path to bin file e.g. URL header, **http://thebeast2.com/repo** Click **DONE**, Click **OK** twice and then **BACK** arrow on remote once.

Click System Settings in the **ADDONS** section, click on Right side of panel turn on unknown sources choose **YES**, Back arrow on the remote twice.

Under **ADDONS**, click on box top left icon below the KODI logo.

Select **INSTALL** from **ZIP**, click on **REPO**, Click on **BIN File**. Wait till it downloads (ICON will appear on right hand side of screen, indicating that download was complete).

Click on **MY-ADDON'S**, click on **VIDEO-ADDON'S**

Select whichever item is located in this area. E.g. The Beast or Wizard etc. It should error out and ask you to sign in. If you have already done so then click and hold on the beast wizard item and select add-on settings. Enter your email and password. Click **OK** when done and now you can re-select it and install the build. **NOTE: Wait till it fully downloads and then wait till it fully installs. This could take about 10-15 minutes.**

When complete, Click DONE. ***NOTE: DO NOT CLICK FORCE SHUTDOWN as it will corrupt the install we just finished doing.*** Typically, on ANDROID BOXES there is no way to tell it to reboot so we will have to manually reboot the BOX by unplugging the power cable from the unit wait 3 seconds and then apply power back. This is normal and will NOT hurt your DEVICE. **When KODI reloads PLEASE give it some time (5 mins) to build its menu structure.**

NOTE: When your device comes back on, start KODI and you should now see The Beast build. It's obvious because there is a new skin color and the wallpaper says BEAST. If it doesn't then what I found out is that you MUST uninstall KODI completely and reload KODI first (Please see tutorial "HOW TO PROGRAM A AMAZON FIRESTICK TV FOR KODI"). Then follow this tutorial again.
